School attire and grooming plays a key role in promoting

School Uniform – General

- No form of alteration is allowed.
- Girls Culottes must be at knee length.
- Responsibility of students to buy new culottes/pants as they grow.
- Upper Sec Boys no tapering of the pants.



School Uniform – PE Attire

- PE attire can only be worn on days when there are PE lessons.
- If you do not have any PE lessons on that day, you are to come in full school uniform.
- PE shirt and shorts can only be worn during PE lessons and PE shirt must be tucked in at all times.

Should be kept short and neat.

Hair should not touch the eyes, ears and collar














Hair (Girls)

Types of Shoes allowed for Bukit View students









<u>Trackshoes</u> or canvas shoes which are black, white or grey based are allowed. Shoes with other colours are not allowed.
